Botox® was approved by the FDA in 2010, and is currently **the only FDA approved preventive treatment for chronic migraines**.

You can consider Botox® as an option for your patients who have **nausea, vision loss, and difficulty speaking** resulting from the beginning symptoms of a migraine. Additionally, the benefits of using Botox® include, but are not limited to:

- Prevents on average 8 to 9 headache days and probable migraine days a month
- Very low risk and discomfort
- Reduces total cumulative headache hours per month on average by 107-134 hours
- Prevents migraines and headaches before they begin

Botox® is injected every 12 weeks into muscles on the face and neck with small needles. The injection areas include Corrugator, Procerus, Frontalis, Occipitalis, Cervical Paraspinal Muscle group, Temporalis, and the Trapezius. Once Botox® is injected, it takes at least 2 treatments that are 12 weeks apart to determine how well Botox® is working for the patient.
